## **Ramblings-Fr. Brankin**

### Sacred Heart of Jesus

Well another feast we did not talk about during the Spring was the Feast of the Sacred Heart Jesus.

But since it is still June, the month of the Sacred Heart, it would be good for us to remember this beautiful Catholic devotion to Jesus. I know it was my mothers most beloved devotion. She prayed to the Sacred Heart all the time. I remember so well the phrase about Jesus' "open, broken heart."

Of course one reason for the popularity of the devotion are the promises of the Nine First Fridays of Sacred Heart of Jesus. Jesus promised us through St. Margaret that anyone who receives Holy Communion-the first Fridays of nine months in a row—out of love for the Sacred Heart of Jesus—will not die without receiving the Sacraments.

And I am convinced that is why so many people—even those who haven't been to church in 50 years—so often get a priest by their deathbed—why we get so many calls to MacNeal. These people—when they were children—made the nine first Fridays

We give Jesus the title of the Sacred Heart because the heart is the symbol of love—par excellence. With Jesus—his Heart is even portrayed as burning—and that tell us that His love for is all-consuming .

The Sacred Heart of Jesus reminds us that the love of God for us is freely offered and totally undeserved.

He who knew no sin—He who was God Almighty Himself, and who could have looked at our sinfulness, our pride, our ignorance, our petty crimes or grand felonies—He who could have annihilated us in an instant or crushed us in the twinkling of an eye—does not do so. He simply forgives us.

He takes our punishment—our death—our guilt upon Himself and asks His Father to forgive us by means of His Crucifixion—by means of his sublime sacrifice. And of course there is nothing in it for Him—except the joy that we are with Him. He suffers for us—so that we would not suffer eternally in Hell.

God could easily have said—and literally "To Hell with them." But He did not.

And all we have to do is accept His forgiveness and promise that we will sin no more. This is true love—selfless—and totally directed towards the person who is loved.

True love comes from God—it is the way He is. And for us it means that someone wants good things for the person they love—and they will do anything—endure anything—suffer anything for that person's well-being.

True love is so profound and deep that it means that you would die for the person you love—if by means of your death—the one you love, could live.

That is the meaning of the Sacred Heart.

If you have ever seen a painting or a picture of the Sacred Heart of Jesus—you know what kind of love we are talking about—a tender love—a forgiving love—a sacrificial love.

Jesus' one hand points to His heart—and the other is held out to us. We can just about hear The Sacred Heart saying to us—"Listen, I died for you—and right this moment I offer you my open, broken heart. Will you accept it?"

How unspeakably beautiful are these images of the Sacred Heart.

I never understood the people who say that they were taught that God was vengeful and mean and ready to pounce on us at every turn with punishments and chastisements. Sort of like the Terrible OZ!

No. We were actually taught that God is the Sacred Heart—gentle, tender—forgiving. We were taught that God loves us—and only wants good things for us—like our salvation—and that He would even die—if by His death—we people could live. That's love-

If some people think God is mean—maybe it is because they also misunderstand love. Modern love is about taking—and grabbing and grasping. And woe to the loved one if you don't get what you want.

Modern love says that all that counts is my pleasure—and forget you.

And I believe that that is why today there are so many broken families and hurtful relationships—we don't understand that love is not about what I want—it is not about pleasure and desire—Love is not measured or exemplified by what people are doing for me—or giving me—love is about giving and donating and sacrificing.

Love is about what I must do for others—and that means taking on burdens and responsibilities and doing our duty as a man or as a woman—or as a child.

Yes—it is part of love to do ones duty. To live up to our responsibilities—even when it is difficult and irksome.

Love is fulfilling the duty to spend time with those you love and staying home when you'd rather be out.

Love is the duty to stay faithful when you would rather stray—to talk when you would rather be silent—to do something for your family—when you would rather be doing nothing.

Husbands and wives—fathers and mothers—brothers and sisters—if they love one another—must never ask of those they love “What will you do for me?”

They must always ask “What may I do for you, my beloved? Tell me and I will do it. No matter the cost. No matter the price. I will do for you what is good for you—even if the price is my comfort or my convenience or my effort—or even if the price is my life.

That kind of love does not come from Facebook or movies or music. That kind of love comes from God—and we better learn about it.

A beautiful old Catholic custom was to have a picture of the Sacred Heart of Jesus displayed prominently somewhere in our house so that we could look at Jesus and see His Divine tenderness and contrast it with our hardness and help us to say to Him “Jesus, Look not on our sins, but on our Faith— do not consider what we truly deserve, but grant us your forgiveness.”

That's the kind of love we see in the Picture of the Sacred Heart—and it creates the same kind of love in us—a true love—a sacrificial love—a forgiving love—an enduring love.

And nothing speaks of that kind of love quite like the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
